



Our hunting season begins March 1 and runs through the end of October. The cooler months are from May to August, with moderate temperatures in the early mornings/evenings. Complete packing list available at www.numzaan.com.

As you disembark the plane at O.R. Tambo International Airport in Johannesburg, you will be met by an airport official and escorted through immigration, baggage claim, and customs to your PH, who will be waiting to transport you to the hunting camp.

For normal plains game hunts, we recommend a .30 caliber rifle with a minimum bullet weight of 180 grains. Common calibers used are .308 Win, .30-06, and .300 Win Mag.

It is not necessary to bring malaria medication as the area is a very low to no-risk malaria zone. There are also no compulsory vaccinations required to enter South Africa; however, we do recommend getting Hepatitis A, B, and Tetanus vaccinations prior to leaving for your safari.

All our lodges have either permanent electricity or are supplied by solar systems or generators. The current is 220 V, so it would be advisable to bring a power adapter.

WiFi is available at every camp; however, the bandwidth can be somewhat limiting if you wish to send or receive large files.

Hides are meticulously skinned, tagged, and chemically preserved before they are transported to Swift Dip-our local Dip & Pack agent. Numzaan Safaris will make all necessary documentation and arrangements to have your trophies safely and legally exported.

In all cases, a minimum deposit of \$1,000.00 US must be paid to Numzaan Safaris to confirm your booking. We advise all our clients to make a pre-safari payment prior to their date of arrival at Numzaan Safaris.
